Traipse around the tallest trees in the world! We'll walk through old growth redwoods, overlook a waterfall and chase down Banana Slugs while experiencing redwood forest ecology. MODERATE HIKING

ARROYO SECO RIVER HIKE (AGES 13-17)

Discover a rushing river oasis in the dry reaches of the Salinas Valley. Hike along arid cliffs and descend into the cool river gorge where we'll splash through the river to explore the wilderness off the beaten path. STRENUOUS HIKING
